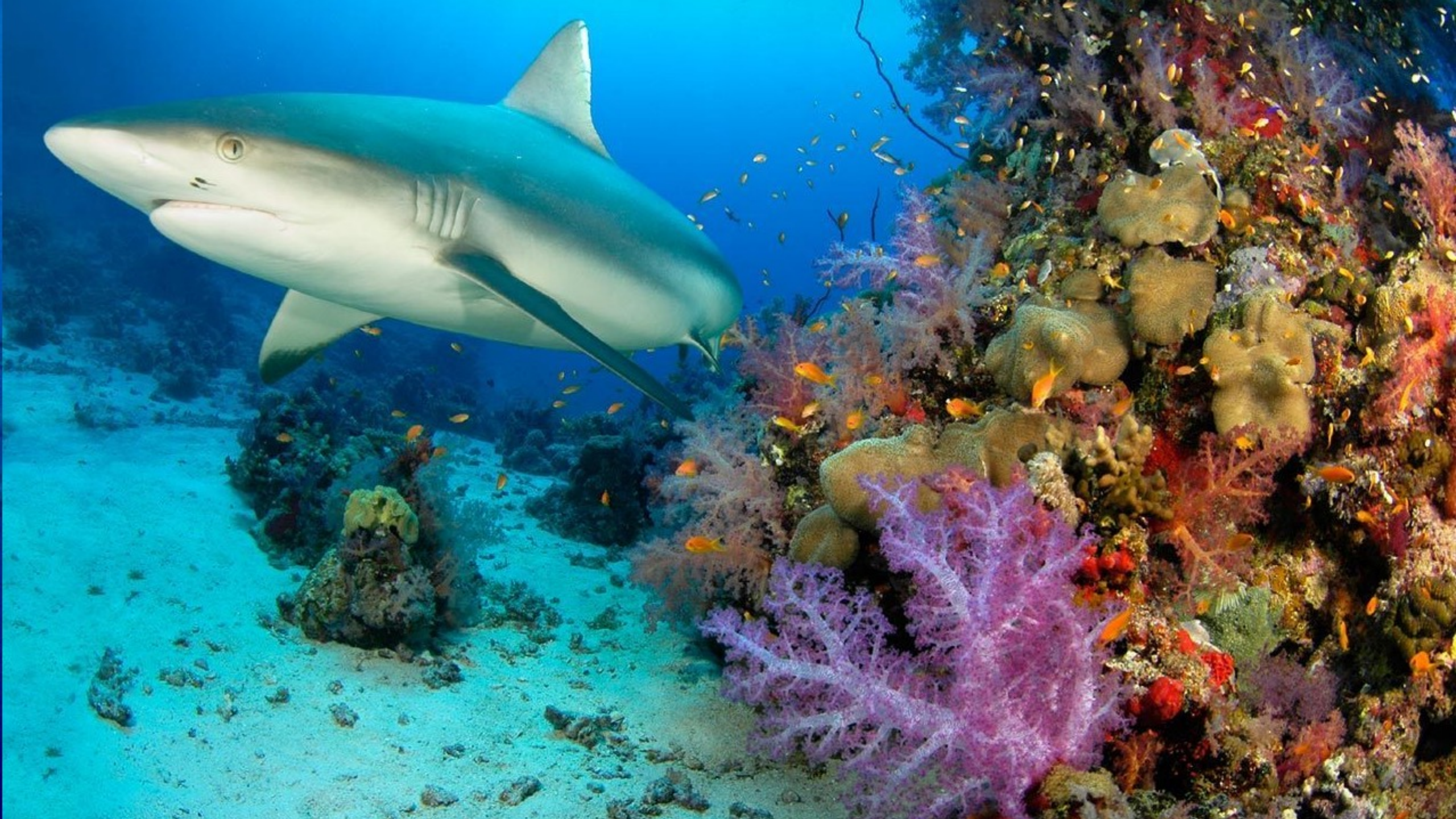




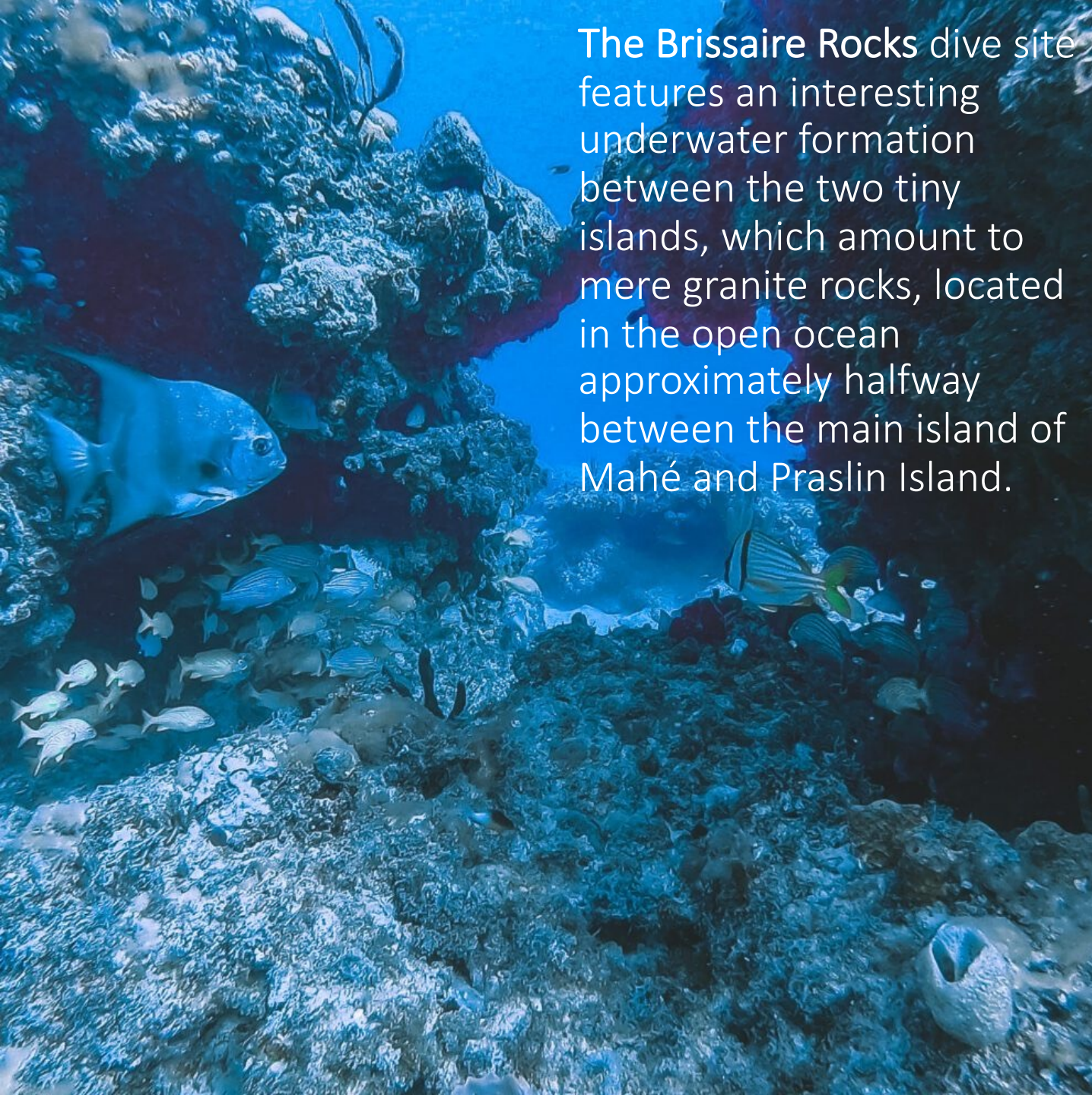


Marienne Rocks - Praslin
